



2+ Hour Tape Transfer Authorization Form

With our standard video transfer process, MemoryHub transfers the first two hours of your videotape to DVD. For many consumer videotape formats (such as VHS-C, Video8, MiniDV, MicroMV, VHS recorded in SP mode, etc.), this is not an issue, as these tapes do not typically hold more than two hours of content on the tape. However, for Betamax and VHS tapes recorded in LP or XP modes, the actual video content on the tape can exceed two hours, and reach a total of four, six or even eight hours in total length.

If you would like to have the extra footage beyond the two hour mark, please sign and return this form indicating that you authorize MemoryHub to create the additional DVDs, and that you agree to pay the additional costs associated with the transfer. Each additional zero- to two-hour segment on the tape will be treated and charged for as an individual tape, and you will be charged accordingly.

I hereby authorize MemoryHub to transfer any and all content beyond the two-hour mark on the videotapes sent in as part of my order to DVD.

I understand that I will be contacted once the DVDs have been produced, and agree to provide payment for the resulting charges associated with the additional transfers.
